The Junior Fazio Course

Whether you have a budding golfer on your hands, or you want to get the next generation in the game so the whole family can enjoy outings together, our Junior Fazio Course on the Harbor Course is one of the best opportunities to get wee ones, tweens and teens swinging their clubs. Our set of junior tees ranges from a 45 yard, par 3 to the longest hole, a 300 yard, par 5. The course is geared towards kids, but still has a healthy dose of terrain with 2971 yards. Extension 2301.

Practice Facility

Our practice facility is located across from the Links Clubhouse, and includes a driving range, chipping area and putting green. Both pro shops rent clubs and other gear. Extension 2180.
